

1/ HANOI CITY TOUR (half day)

Depart at 08:15 Return 12:15

Booking must be made by 20 hours in advance

Service includes transfer, guide, cyclo ride & admission fees

Introduction:

Being the capital of Vietnam for a thousand years, Hanoi enjoys the charm of peaceful lakes, shaded boulevards, verdant public parks, age-old pagodas, and ancient architectural features. A visit to the most famous sights of Hanoi such as Hochiminh Mausoleum (outside for photo shots only), Presidential Palace, Literature Temple, Tran Quoc Pagoda, etc. will broadly extend your knowledge of Vietnamese history and culture. The tour also includes a cyclo ride to Dong Xuan Market, the largest market in Hanoi which is located in the heart of the Old Quarter. After that, you can enjoy your shopping with a variety of fruits, clothing, souvenirs and other specialities.

2/ DUONG LAM ANCIENT TOWN (half day)

Depart at 08:00 Return 13:00

Introduction:

A trip to Duong Lam ancient village, 50 km west of Hanoi, is featuring distinctive traits of Vietnamese village in the Red River Delta, where are still preserved many ancient houses aged up to 400 years old. Laterite and mud, the two materials that are abundant in the area, can be seen on house walls, temple walls, gates, wells, and so forth. If you visit Duong Lam during the harvest season, you can smell the freshly cut rice and see farmers drying straw along country lanes. Some historic sites included in the tour are King Phung Hung and King Ngo Quyen's Temple. Mong Phu Communal House, etc. The trip also offers a great chance to explore the architecture of this well-preserved village while you wander along its narrow alleyways, visits temple, and most interesting of all, chat with locals living in the ancient houses.

3/ BAT TRANG POTTERY VILLAGE (half day)

Depart at 13:30 Return 16:30

Introduction: *Bat Trang is a pottery village with a history of 500 years. The vitality of the village is still shown by its thousands of kilns burning day and night. Escorted by a local potter guide, you will thrill to the sights and sounds of the kilns, explore generation-to-generation pottery techniques and get to know the potters' daily life. You can also try making some small pottery pieces, which will be kept as their memory of the trip.*

4/ HALONG BAY (full day with lunch)

Introduction:

A boat cruise in Ha Long Bay, a world natural heritage site recognized by UNESCO, is absolutely marvelous. Carved through ages by natural elements, the limestone has been transformed into spectacular caves and grottos, some threading through stone pillars, other towering to cathedral heights that rise high above the emerald sea. Moreover, in natural sculptures of animals, many of these islands have been given individual names that remind of intriguing legends: Dog Island, Incense Urn Island, Fighting Cock Island, Heaven Gate Cave, Dau Go Grotto etc.
